

Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:

SECTION 1. In the Constitution of the state of Colorado, **add** section 33 to Article II as follows:

Section 33. Right to be born.

CHILDREN HAVE THE RIGHT TO CONTINUE LIVING FROM THE MOMENT THEY ARE CONCEIVED. GOVERNMENT SHALL PROTECT THAT RIGHT, INCLUDING: THE GOVERNMENT SHALL NOT PERMIT BUSINESSES TO OPERATE THAT INTENTIONALLY END THE LIVES OF CHILDREN, THE GOVERNMENT SHALL NOT PERMIT DRUGS IN THE STATE INTENDED TO END THE LIVES OF CHILDREN, AND THE GOVERNMENT SHALL NOT INFRINGE UPON A CHILD'S RIGHT TO CONTINUE LIVING.

SECTION 2. This provision shall be self-executing, shall take effect, and shall apply beginning December 25, 2026, if approved by the vote of the people, and is not retroactive. If any part of this provision is found to be unenforceable, the remainder of this provision shall remain in effect.
