

*Be it Enacted by the People of the State of Colorado:*

**Section 1.** In the constitution of the state of Colorado, article IV, **add** section 24 as follows:

**Section 24. Foreign Affairs.**

THE GOVERNOR MAY MAKE TREATIES, WHICH THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY APPROVE OR REJECT. THE GOVERNOR MAY PROPOSE THE WITHDRAWAL FROM A TREATY, WHICH THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY APPROVE OR REJECT. THE GOVERNOR MAY NOMINATE AMBASSADORS, WHICH THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY MAY CONFIRM OR REJECT. THE GOVERNOR MAY APPOINT SUB-AMBASSADOR LEVEL DIPLOMATIC REPRESENTATIVES, REPRESENT COLORADO AT MEETINGS BETWEEN WORLD LEADERS, AND RECEIVE AMBASSADORS.

**Section 2. Effective date.** This initiative takes effect on January 14th, 2027.
