### **MOTION TO CONTINUE HEARING AND RELATED DEADLINES**

---

The Elections Division of the Secretary of State files this Motion to Continue the hearing set in this matter and related deadlines for prehearing statements and exhibits. As good cause, the Division states:

1. In this matter, the Elections Division brings claims against four candidate committees, Clark Callahan for DCSD, KyrziaParker4DCSD, TonyRyan4DCSD, and Kelly Denzler for DCSD.
2. On January 27, 2026, the Hearing Officer served a Scheduling Order in this matter. The Scheduling Order set a Hearing for Friday, February 27, 2026, at 3:00pm.
3. The Scheduling Order also set dates for prehearing statements (February 13, 2026), exhibit exchange and filing (February 13, 2026), and an exhibit list (February 16, 2026).

4. In the Scheduling Order, the Hearing Officer noted that none of the Respondent candidate committees had “filed an Answer or entered an appearance.”

5. Earlier today, on January 29, 2026, the Division served its First Set of Discovery requests on Respondents.

6. Under the Secretary’s rules, Respondents’ answers to those requests are due on or before February 19, 2026. 8 CCR 1505-3, Rule 3.10.1(b)(1).

7. Because Respondents’ answers to those requests are not due until after the deadline for prehearing statements, the Division respectfully requests a continuance so that the responses may be incorporated into its prehearing statement and exhibit list.

8. Moreover, the Division has had productive conversations concerning resolution of the allegations in the Division’s Complaint with at least one of the Respondent candidate committees. Respondents’ answers to the discovery requests are necessary to finalize those discussions and are likely to result in a settlement as to at least one of the Respondent committees.

Accordingly, the Division respectfully requests that the Hearing set for February 27, 2026, be continued to a date in March that is convenient for the Hearing Officer, and that the February 13, 2026, and February 16, 2026, deadlines be continued accordingly.
